Before going to the Agenda item-wise, the Academic Council discussed the Minutes of the last meeting of the Council held on 9th July, 2013 and confirmed the same. Itemwise action taken report on recommendations of the Academic Council made in its last meeting was presented by the Member-Secretary.

The Academic Council deliberated upon the Agenda items and made recommendations as given below:

2 Inthe

Item No. 2.01: To consider and approve Ordinance on Creation of Faculties.

The Academic Council was apprised that the Sub-section (2) of Section 31 of the Indira Gandhi Delhi Technical University for Women Act 2012 read with Statute-14 of the Indira Gandhi Delhi Technical University for Women (First) Statutes 2012 inter alia provide that the first Ordinance shall be made by the Vice-Chancellor with the prior approval of the Government. Therefore, a draft Ordinance on the subject matter, in the shape of Notification, has been submitted to the Govt. of NCT of Delhi for approval.

The Council noted the provisions of the proposed First Ordinance and agreed to with the same. However, the Council suggested that at the time of creation of Faculty of Business Studies in the Department of Commerce, Finance discipline may also be considered.

Item No.2.02: To consider and approve M.Tech (ECE), weekend programme at IGDTUW.

The Council approved the proposed scheme of examination and syllabi for M.Tech(ECE) weekend programme and recommended the following eligibility criteria:

The candidate should have a minimum of 60% marks or equivalent grade in the qualifying exam(s) given below:

 B.E./B.Tech in Electronics and Communication/Electronics; and Electronics/Applied Electronics and Instrumentation/Instrumentation and Control/ Electronics and Instrumentation/Electronics/B.Tech.(CSE)/ B.Tech.(IT)/ MCA or equivalent/ M.Sc. Electronics or equivalent.

OR

2. Passed the AMIE/AMIETE Examination in Electronics.

OR

3. B.Sc. and have done (NIELIT)DOEACC 'C' level (for lateral entry in the second year of M.Tech.(ECE) Part Time Programme). The Council deliberated on the issue of lateral entry being given to 'C' level students and recommended that candidates with B.Sc. degree and 'C' level qualifications be considered for lateral entry to M.Tech program.

Item No. 2.03: To consider and approve Scholarship for M.Tech (regular) students.

The Council approved Stipend (instead of Scholarship) of Rs.5000/- per month to the top five meritorious students for the first year and on the basis of academic performance for the second year in each branch of M.Tech.(Regular) Programmes.

Item No.2.04: To consider and approve the policy on the admission of students in the B.Tech program.

The following admission policy for B.Tech students was approved by the Council:

The IGDTUW shall conduct the admissions to the B. Tech. Program on the basis of the rank prepared by CBSE in combination to the score of individual examinee in JEE-Main & Senior School Certificate Examination under 10 + 2 system of education or equivalent.

The Council authorized the Vice-Chancellor to form a committee for determining the eligibility criteria for admission to B.Tech program of IGDTUW.

Item No.2.05: To consider & approve the fee Structure for B.Tech/MCA.

The following fee structure was approved for students to be admitted in 2014.

Examination Fee (per annum)	5,000/-
Student welfare Fee (per annum)	5,000/-
Security Deposit (Payable only at the time of admission, refundable)	5,000/-

Item.No.2.06:

To consider and approve the ordinance for conduct and evaluation of examinations for programmes leading to all Bachelor/ Master Degrees and post-graduate diplomas at IGDTUW and regulations on Unfair means.

Recommended for approval of Ordinance and the Regulation of Unfair means for approval by the Board of Management.

Item.No.2.07: To consider and approve the ordinances on the admission of students to Ph.D programmes of IGDTUW.

The Council recommended the Ordinance for approval by the Board of Management. However, deliberating upon the admission criteria suggested for (i) deletion of 2 years of experience for students with MCA degree for regular Ph.D in Computer Applications discipline and (ii) inserting "relevant" word before work experience required for part-time applicant of Ph.D programmes. Admission procedure and following fee structure was approved:

To consider & approve Award of Teaching-cum-Research Fellowship in various branches of Engineering, Sciences and Technology.

Approved.

Item No.2.09:

To consider & approve ordinance on maintenance of discipline among the students of the University.

The Council advised to review the draft Ordinance incorporating recommendations of Raghwan Committee and provisions of the UGC regulations on Ragging.

Item No 2.10:

To consider and approve the panel of experts to be invited to various selection committees and expert committees of IGDTUW for ECE/ CSE/ MAE/ IT/ Physics/ Chemistry/ Maths/ Communication Skills/ Management Studies.

The Council approved the panel of experts and authorized the Vice Chancellor to add names thereto. Members were also requested to send more names of experts for including in the panels.

Item no.2.11: To consider & approve prevention of Sexual Harassment.

The Council advised to review the proposed Ordinance on prevention of sexual harassment adopting provisions of the "The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 (No.14 of 2013) notified on 23rd April, 2013 and which came into force w.e.f. 9th December, 2013.
