**Important notice for all the candidates (non- exempted applicants)
appearing in RAT 2019 to be held on 3rd, July 2019 from 10:30 A.M.
to 12:30 P.M.**

The Candidates, who have applied for RAT 2019 which will be conducted on 3rd, July, 2019 from 10:30 A.M to 12:30 P.M may please note:

- 1) The admit card for RAT 2019 has been generated and forwarded on your email id. If any discrepancies found, please report to examination division on or before 01/07/2019 latest by 3:00 P.M.
- 2) Bring Identity Card issued by Employer/Adhaar Card/Election Card/Driving License/Passport in Original for proof of identity.
- 3) Bring two copies of the admit card with duly pasted recent passport size photographs in both the admit card with self attested.
- 4) No candidate will be allowed to appear for the examination without admit card. The Admit Card must be produced for verification in the examination hall.
- 5) Hand Bags, Purse, Electronic gadgets like Mobile, Calculator etc. are not allowed inside the Examination Hall.
- 6) Report to Examination Centre at least 30 minutes before commencement of Written Examination.
- 7) No Candidate will be allowed to examination hall once the examination has started.
- 8) Candidate can leave the examination hall only after scheduled time of exam is over.
- 9) Candidate should retain one copy of the Admit card (with Invigilator's Signature) till the admission process is finished. Second copy should be handed over to the Invigilator at the time of written Test. Duplicate admit cards will not be issued after the test.
- 10) Issue of the admit card does not necessarily mean acceptance of eligibility which will be further scrutinized at subsequent stages of admission process.
- 11) Candidates must sit according to the seat allocated to them.
- 12) Use only Black/Blue ball point pen for filling of the OMR Answer Sheet.

- 14) The applicants are advised to check the location of University well in advance so that they can reach their examination centre/Hall without any problem/delay on the date of Entrance examination.
- 15) It is also informed that in any circumstances "NO CANDIDATES WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE EXAMINATION CENTRE AFTER THE SCHEDULED COMMENCEMENT OF ENTRANCE EXAMINATION".
